Between shows: The theatre will be sanitized between performances so all dancers & families will need to check-out after the first show & check back in for the second show. The approximate running time of the production is 2 hours including a 15-minute intermission. We will just need a few minutes following the first show to get the dancers ready to leave.

To make the check-out process easy for all parents & students please adhere to the following schedule. Please note parents may socially distance in the lobby or outdoors while waiting for their child's check out time.

2:30 - Elementary - Advanced

Saint Anselms has ample green space so please feel welcome to pack a picnic & get fresh air in between shows. There is no eating in costume so please pack a change of clothes and leave costumes hanging up at the theatre in between. Make-up & hair will need to be touched up prior to checking back in.

4:00pm Evening Show: All dancers must arrive no earlier or later than the check in time below with hair & makeup touched up & ready to put their costume on.

- **Check-In for all dancers: 3:15pm**

Audience Guidelines

- Audience members should arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to the performance and go directly to their seat once the theatre doors open.

Dana Center COVID-19 Guidelines:
