2021 Spring Performance Costume Deposit Changes

Our Costume Policy States: "Each year costumes are ordered for each class in our spring production. A mandatory costume deposit is due on November 1st:

o Child Sizes: \$60.00 each o Adult Sizes: \$75.00 each

No more than 4 costume deposits for students who take multiple or unlimited classes!

A late fee of \$5.00 per costume, per month will be added to the final balance if the deposits are not paid by November 30th. If costumes are ordered after the order has been placed a fee of \$25 will be added for processing and shipping. There are no costume refunds if a student drops class after November 30th."

NEW COVID-19 Guidelines

Arrival Procedures – Starting 10/19/20

- 1. Due to the weather getting colder, students will now be permitted to enter the building in time for their classes. Please arrive no more than 5 minutes prior to your class time and wait until the door is propped open to enter the studio & use the sanitizer.
- 2. Students under the age of 9 must have a parent bring them upstairs to be dropped off in the hallway (parents with children age 5 & younger may sit in the lobby during their child's class)
- 3. Staff and students must wear a mask into the building. Students may remove their masks for class as long as they maintain a 6 foot distance.
- 4. Staff and students must wear a mask into the building and will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon entering the building. Masks may be removed for classes.
- 5. Please bring as few items into the studio as possible and have all items in your own personal dance bag.
- 6. The onsite water fountain and microwave will be off limits at this time. Bring a large water bottle & food will be limited to healthy granola or protein bars & must be eaten in the kitchen.
- 7. All hard surfaces will be sanitized between classes. Please see the "studio schedule" on www.newenglandschoolofdance.com for sanitizing times.

Dismissal Procedures

- 1. Parents should arrive on time to pick-up students from the **back parking lot**. Students will be walked outside of the building by a staff member.
- 2. Non-driving students must be released to a parent / guardian known to the studio. Please email or call us if someone else will be picking up that day.

- 3. We also ask that parents meet students at the back door instead of waiting in their cars so we can ensure all students are picked up safely.
- 4. Dancers may only be in the studio when they are attending their registered classes. If they have a break between classes they will be asked to wear their mask. All other dancers must leave the studio at the conclusion of their class.

Illness Procedures

- 1. If you have a cough, fever, or are sick please stay home.
- 2. Please, do not come to the studio if you or someone you have been exposed to has COVID, or had COVID-like symptoms, within the past 14 days.
- 3. Please, do not come to the studio if you have traveled to an area where there are high amounts of COVID-19 cases for 14 days.
- 4. Dancers who test positive for COVID-19 must remain home until they have been cleared by a doctor and must provide documentation.
- 5. We ask that you follow same protocol as Public Schools and please notify us of any potential symptoms, or need to take a COVID test, and wait to return until after test has returned negative.

How to Register and Set up Autopay

- 1. Visit www.newenglandschoolofdance.com
- 2. Click "Fall Programs & Schedule"
- 3. Click "Find Your Level" for age appropriate classes, dress code and more
- 4. Click "Studio Schedule" for a full view of all classes and sanitizing times
- 5. Click "Login/Register" in the upper right corner
- 6. Click "Enroll in a Class" to see classes available based on your child's age
- 7. Complete by paying the \$45 Registration fee (includes online video downloads of shows)
- 8. Enter your preferred payment information & select "yes" to "Autopay" If you haven't already done so, please be sure to fill out the Autopay portion of your account to help ensure that all payments run smoothly.
